"Simple problem being" is a visual artist based in Singapore, specialising in creating surreal characters with distorted body movements using spray-paint and acrylic brush techniques. Inspired by New York 90s graffiti, SPB's style is characterised by bold colours, intricate line work, and exaggerated forms. This approach has evolved over time to become a distinct and recognisable style that combines elements of both graffiti and contemporary art.

As one of South East Asia's pioneers of bass driven music and Syndicate's

co-founder, Singapore based Kiat has been championing the adventurous side of electronica with quality breaks, rolling bass-lines and leftfield influences over many years. With tunes sought after by the top DJs such as Goldie, Doc Scott, and Marky, Kiat has been featured as the "Leader of the Nu-Skool" in international music magazines.
